## ENERGY MONITORING PROGRAM (EMP) SOFTWARE LICENCE AGREEMENT (where EMP Multi is provided to the Customer)

### 1. Licence

Metering Dynamics grants the Customer a personal, non-exclusive, non-transferable Licence to use the Energy Monitoring Program software (the “**Software**”) solely for the Customer’s internal business purposes within Australia on a single computer/workstation only. This Licence for the Software may not be shared or used concurrently on different computers.

### 2. Restrictions On Use

The Customer must not:

- 2.1. sell, rent, lend or lease the Software;
- 2.2. reverse engineer, decompile or disassemble the Software except to the extent that such activity is expressly permitted by law;
- 2.3. separate component parts of the Software for use on more than one computer;
- 2.4. permit others to use the Software; or
- 2.5. copy the Software.

### 3. Copyright And Title

Title, ownership rights and Intellectual Property Rights in the Software remain with Metering Dynamics. The Software is protected by copyright and other intellectual property laws and by international treaty.

### 4. Limited Warranty

Metering Dynamics warrants to the Customer that for 30 days from the date the Software is delivered, it will perform substantially in accordance with the documentation entitled “EMP Multi Warranty” that may be accessed at [www.meteringdynamics.com.au](http://www.meteringdynamics.com.au) as at the Commencement Date and will be free from defects in material and workmanship. This warranty is not transferable.

### 5. Limitation Of Liability

- 5.1. Subject to clause 4, and except as set out in clause 5.3, all terms, conditions, warranties, undertakings, inducements or representations whether express, implied, statutory or otherwise relating in any way to the Software are expressly excluded. Without limitation Metering Dynamics is not liable for any personal injury, death, damage to property or equipment or loss or damage arising from acts of God, fire, earthquake, flood, electrical storms, lightning strikes, abnormal weather conditions, power supply malfunction, war, terrorism, vandalism or accidents of any kind.
- 5.2. Liability of Metering Dynamics to the Customer for any breach of this Licence or in connection with this Licence is limited to the total amount of the Service Fee and the Upfront Capital Contribution payable by the Customer to Metering Dynamics under the Agreement from the Commencement Date to the end of the Initial Period. Metering Dynamics will not be under any further liability to the Customer in respect of any loss or damage (including consequential loss or damage) however caused (whether by Metering Dynamics’ negligence or otherwise) which may be suffered or incurred or which may arise directly or indirectly from this Licence.
- 5.3. If an Act of Parliament implies in this Licence any term, condition or warranty and that Act avoids or

prohibits provisions in a contract excluding or modifying the application of or the exercise of or liability under those terms, conditions or warranties, the terms, conditions or warranties will be deemed to be included in this Licence. The liability of Metering Dynamics for a breach of those terms, conditions or warranties relating to goods or services is limited, to the extent permitted by law, at the option of Metering Dynamics, to repairing and replacing the goods, acquiring equivalent goods, resupplying the services or the cost of doing any of these things.

- 5.4. Metering Dynamics has no liability or responsibility for Software altered, modified or converted by the Customer or a third party, damages resulting from accident, abuse or misapplication or for problems due to the malfunction of hardware or software not supplied by Metering Dynamics.

### 6. Termination

The Licence issued pursuant to this Software Licence Agreement is effective until terminated by Metering Dynamics and terminates without notice from Metering Dynamics if the Customer fails to comply with any of the terms of this Licence or on 30 days written notice to the Customer if the Sub-Metering Services Agreement is terminated for any reason or the Customer ceases to receive energy metering products or services from Metering Dynamics. Upon termination of this Licence the Customer must immediately destroy the Software and all copies or portions of the Software together with any documentation relating to the installation or operation of the Software.

### 7. Severance

If any provision of this Licence is held invalid, unenforceable or illegal for any reason this Licence will remain otherwise in full force apart from that provision which will be deemed to be deleted.

### 8. Governing Law

This Licence is governed by the laws of the State of Queensland, Australia and represents the entire understanding and agreement between the Parties about the Software.

### 9. Variation

This Licence may not be varied except in writing signed by the Parties.
